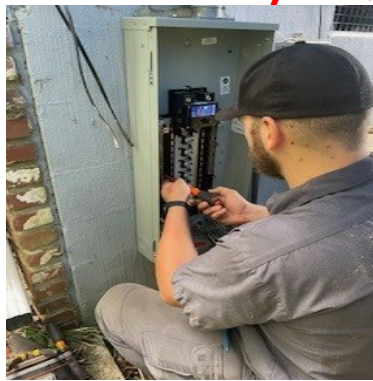
Of course, even on a holiday, our commitment to our
