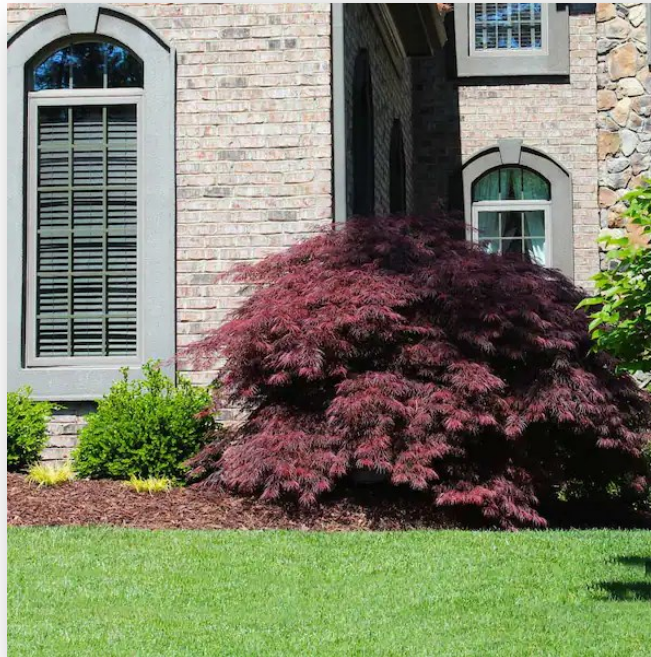

Tamukeyama is a weeping or cascading variety of Japanese Maple. It has finely dissected, lace-like foliage that emerges a deep red or burgundy in spring. The foliage retains its red color throughout the summer and intensifies in the fall, turning shades of crimson and scarlet.
