False Indigo is a summer blooming perennial with a dense clusters of deep indigo colored flowers that develop on long upright spikes. The purple-blue flowers start blooming in May/June covering most of the foliage. The first two years is spent developing its tap roots, afterward blooms are consistent and prolific. After the blooming period the foliage stays in a dense mound.
