The Black Hills Spruce is a naturally symmetrical spruce tree that grows smaller than other spruce varieties. Known for its dense blue-green needles, the Black Hills Spruce offers year round coverage. It is perfect for a variety of landscapes. It can be used as a specimen stand alone tree or it can be joined with multiple others to form a windbreak. Enjoys moist, but well drained soils. Do not plant in a year round wet area.
