Rainier cherries are a hybrid between the Bing and Van cherry varieties, hybridized by researchers at Washington State University in 1952. Rainier cherries are self-sterile, which means that they cannot pollinate themselves and require cross-pollination from another cherry tree. Rainier cherries are known for their sweet, juicy flesh and yellow-red skin with a slight blush. **Pollinators: Bing, Black Tartarian, Stella, And Montmorency.**
