Prairie Dropseed offers mounding tufts of green on a soft, serene scene. In autumn, this clump-forming grass takes on warm tan colors. Tall flower spikes grow above the foliage in late summer. It is a low maintenance grass; simply cut back once a year. It has many uses: native gardens, meadows, rock gardens, and many more. It gives a formal look when planted in mass.
