


# Common Purple Lilac


*(Syringa vulgaris)*

There is little wondering why the lilac is one of the most commonly planted shrubs in the American landscape. One whiff of the intoxicatingly rich fragrant blooms and it becomes clear. Plant this sturdy shrub in full sun and after that it is relatively low maintenance. Lilacs will continuously send up new shoots each year forming a dense thicket. You can prune out the oldest and largest stems (2" or greater) for best flowering.
