Toddlers & Two-Year-Old Classroom

A maximum of ten children may be enrolled in our toddler/two-year-old classroom with two full-time teachers. Self-regulation is a major theme with this age group. Toddlers and Two-year-olds work on potty training, self-serving, handwashing, and oral expression among many other things. Curriculum themes are incorporated and the children participate in "circle time" each morning. In addition, toddlers and two-year-olds are given much opportunity to develop their gross motor skills outside and in our playroom.

Preschool Classroom

The preschool classroom includes three, four and five year-olds. It may have a maximum of 20 children with two full-time teachers. Three is a very transitional age. Teachers work to foster the beginning signs of independence while still providing nurture and care. This class works on letters, numbers, colors, and shapes in addition to language and sensory experiences. Art projects adorn the walls and fine motor activities are a favorite. Independence is the key in our preschool program. Students are maturing rapidly and love to show everyone the new skills they are learning. Math, science, and language skills are of great importance at this age. Teachers and children read, explore, and learn together each day. Field trips that utilize community resources are occasionally taken. Parents have the option of enjoying our program all day or utilizing a part day pre-k program in a neighboring school district.

School Age Classroom

The school age classroom includes five year-olds (those in kindergarten) thru twelve years of age. It may have a maximum of 22 children with two full-time teachers. School agers are very inquisitive and require higher level thinking activities. Teachers provide various activities that promote challenging each individual's thought process and complement the accomplishments achieved at their regular school. This class emphasizes on the child's ability to follow directions through hands-on activities, works on school work that is provided by the center and by their regular school, and accentuates reading as part of their daily routines. During the summer months, children participate in a summer program that stresses thematic units. Field trips are an avid part of the summer program.
