It's hard to believe that just over a year has passed since the floodwaters swept through Northwest Iowa, changing lives and displacing many of our residents in a matter of hours. Among the losses were three Hope Haven residences in Rock Valley: Riverview, a 12-bed apartment complex; Rock Valley 1008, a five-bedroom home; and Redwood, our 12-bed Residential Care Facility. These were more than just buildings—they were homes.

But finally, a year later, we're turning a new page.

We're thrilled to share that Hope Haven has purchased a lot northwest of the Netherlands Christian Reformed School in Rock Valley, where we'll begin building a brand-new home designed for increased accessibility, independence, and comfort.

This is more than a building project to us; it's a symbol of our resilience, love, and dedication after the losses we suffered. We're excited to share more in the months ahead as construction begins and things continue to move forward.

It is so refreshing to see how partnerships within the Church can work together for the glory of God! During the last week of April, I had the opportunity to serve with Central Church - Sioux Falls, Agape Mobility, Cure Hospital, Make Your Mark, and MKC Church in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. This was my first wheelchair distribution trip since starting my employment with Hope Haven International. Over the last seven months, I have learned a lot about what a blessing a new wheelchair can be for individuals and families. However, seeing and experiencing this in person is much different.

Our team consisted of very experienced wheelchair fitters, and other rookies like me. We all got to be a part of something great. We worked with local Ethiopians who have a passion for helping their community. With their support, our group was able to fit 196 people, many who received a wheelchair for the very first time. During our distribution trip, local pastors connected with these recipients and their families, and 89 people committed themselves to Christ! Thank you to all of our supporters and volunteers who help make trips like this possible. The Holy Spirit was ever-present with us, and I will continue to pray for God's leading to help those in need in Ethiopia. It's a great pleasure to be a part of this Kingdom work! Peace and Grace!
