GIVING TUESDAY UPDATE



The CLS positions were filled by Jennie Umland, who brings experience from Iowa's Department of Health and Human Services, and Lacey Juchem, a returning Hope Haven team member known for her collaboration and creativity.

This new team meets weekly to stay aligned and build on their shared goals. Their efforts have already led to major improvements. Open positions have dropped from ten to four, billing processes are more efficient, and homes are more organized and comfortable for clients.

A NEW CHAPTER OF LEADERSHIP IN LE MARS, IA

When faced with change, the Le Mars team at Hope Haven turned a challenge into an opportunity for growth. By May 2025, all three Community Living Supervisor (CLS) positions were vacant. Rather than fill the roles as before, leadership restructured the program to better serve both staff and clients. The new model introduced five Lead positions, one for each home, and two CLS positions, creating a stronger, more connected team.

Four of the new Leads were promoted from within: Angela Igleheart, Chas McGrew, David Doellinger, and Rob Cords, each bringing unique strengths to their roles. Maria Mata, who previously worked at Boys Town, joined as the fifth Lead, offering steady leadership and keen attention to detail.

They've also strengthened community connections by making church attendance and local events a regular part of client life. Team-building activities like a Mental Health Escape Room during DSP Week and communication workshops have helped foster trust and collaboration across all homes.

"As a young leader myself, I'm so grateful to walk alongside this team as they grow in their careers," shared their supervisor. "I cannot wait to witness the continued impact that this team will have not only for Hope Haven, but for the community of Le Mars."

BUILDING HOPE IN SIOUX CENTER: NEW SHOP LOCATION

Hope Haven International Ministries (HHIM) is expanding into Sioux Center, IA through a new partnership with Whispers of Love, Hope, and Joy. Together, they are developing a wheelchair assembly shop that will begin production of the new Hope Haven Tilt-in-Space (TiS) pediatric chair.

The TiS chair has been years in the making and is designed for children who struggle to maintain postural strength or need frequent repositioning for comfort. This innovation will allow HHIM and its partners to serve even more children with customized mobility solutions.

HHIM is also partnering with Double HH Manufacturing in Rock Valley, who assisted in both the design of the TiS chair and the new shop layout. Double HH will produce key components locally for the first 100 chairs to be assembled in Sioux Center—marking HHIM's first physical presence in the community.

The Sioux Center shop represents the next step in HHIM's mission to bring mobility to people around the world.

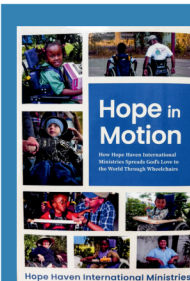
