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Post-operative Instructions

- 1. Avoid strenuous activity for the remainder of the day.
- 2. Proper nutrition is essential for wound healing.
- 3. Avoid manipulation of facial tissues (lifting cheek and lip), which could dislodge sutures.
- 4. Place an ice pack on the surgical site for 20 minutes on, 20 minutes off for the first 6-8 hours following surgery. Do not use ice beyond the day of the surgery.
- 5. Use antibiotic mouth rinse as directed on the bottle.
- 6. The teeth adjacent to the surgical site may be brushed but avoid brushing near the gum line. This can dislodge the sutures or damage the soft tissue.
- 7. Bruising or swelling may occur following endodontic surgery.
- 8. The sutures must be removed to ensure proper healing. This is usually scheduled 5-7 days following surgery.
- 9. Do not hesitate to call with any questions or concerns.
