Attendance & Records	School tracks attendance and progress	Parent is fully responsible for tracking and submitting records
Support Services	Access to IEPs, counselors, Student Engagement Specialists, etc.	S Limited or self-arranged
Learning Structure	Scheduled lessons, deadlines, and pacing guidance with some flexibility	Flexible, parent-determined pacing
Accountability	Students and parents are accountable to school policies and certified educators	Parents oversee accountability
