MAP Testing: Round 2!

All students in grades 6th-8th are required to complete MAP testing in the fall, winter, and spring each school year. All students in grades 6-8 take the Reading and Math tests. Our 6th grade students are also taking MAP Science. The MAP assessments for Reading, Math, and Science help provide teachers, students, and families with valuable information about students' skills, needs and progress towards mastery of SC State Standards.

Students complete MAP tests at home, on Zoom with their teachers. A laptop computer with a working camera is required to successfully complete the test.

Math with Dr. Coyle

Celebrations from Math

- 6th graders are starting to collaborate more often with each other, which makes class more fun and engaging
- Over 90% of students attend live lessons each day! 
- 8th graders Unit 2 Test: Average of 83%!
- Students are engaging in retake opportunities and taking initiative to join extra help Zoom sessions!

ELA Classes Have Been Diving Into

- 7th graders are finishing up their 1st informational essays, they have done a great job as we have working through the writing process as class and learned about MLA formatting, citing sources, and created works cited pages
- 8th graders are above to dive into their narrative writing unit by creating a story from their own imagination as a way to review character development and plot

Science with Ms. Farmer

Science Class Highlights

- 6th graders are beginning a new unit on the structure and function of cells and their organelles. The class will learn how cells work together to form various organ systems. The focus will be on nervous system structure and function. ↗
- 7th graders are learning how and why objects in the physical world move and change position. They will learn about position, displacement, speed, and velocity in the coming weeks. ↗
- 8th graders are continuing to learn about Earth's place in the universe by studying our solar system, and Earth's interactions with the sun and moon. Students will continue to observe moon phases over the course of 15 days by keeping a moon journal! ↗

History Class Highlights

- Students have collaboratively practiced and applied historical vocabulary working in pairs through collaboration - we love seeing peer interaction in class!
- Students reimagined perspectives from the Revolutionary War, considering the beliefs and opinions of Patriots and Loyalists

Computer Class Highlights

- Students are strengthening their math skills through real-world problem-solving and exploring strategies that build confidence and understanding while writing simple programs in Python. Students are encouraging logical thinking, creativity, and connections between math and computing.

PE and Health Highlights

- 6th graders in PE have been focusing on fitness assessments and learning how different tests can give us information about our personal risk level for chronic diseases.


