Position Summary

Garrow Oil & Propane is looking for a dependable, mechanically inclined person to fill a hands-on Lubricant & Maintenance Specialist position.

This is a varied, all-around role that includes delivering lubricants and portable fuel tanks, repairing and maintaining fuel equipment, cleaning tanks, helping around the shop, and taking care of whatever needs to be done to support daily operations.

The right person will enjoy working with tools, solving problems, learning about lubricant and fuel products, and moving between different types of work throughout the day.

Primary Responsibilities

- Deliver bulk and packaged lubricants using a lube truck or other company vehicle.
- Deliver, place, exchange, retrieve, and move portable fuel tanks.
- Deliver drums, barrels, lubricant containers, and related products.
- Load and unload products, tanks, tools, and equipment.
- Inspect, troubleshoot, maintain, and repair fuel pumps, hoses, meters, nozzles, fittings, and related equipment.
- Clean, inspect, and prepare fuel tanks for delivery, installation, removal, or reuse.
- Assist with installing, servicing, and removing customer fuel tanks and dispensing equipment.
- Perform general maintenance and repair work around the shop, warehouse, yard, and company facilities.
- Help maintain trucks, trailers, tools, and other company equipment.
- Receive, organize, and move products and supplies in the warehouse and yard.
- Keep trucks, tanks, equipment, and work areas clean, safe, and organized.
- Perform pre-trip and post-trip inspections and report vehicle or equipment concerns.
- Complete delivery tickets, inspection records, and other required paperwork accurately.

- Follow all DOT, hazardous-materials, environmental, and company safety requirements.
- Provide dependable and professional service when working at customer locations.
- Assist coworkers and take on other duties as needed to keep the business running smoothly.

Required Qualifications

- Valid Class B Commercial Driver's License.
- Safe driving record and commitment to safe work practices.
- Mechanical ability and experience using common hand and power tools.
- Ability to identify problems and complete basic equipment and facility repairs.
- Willingness to perform a combination of delivery, maintenance, shop, warehouse, and outdoor work.
- Dependable, self-motivated, and able to work independently.
- Strong work ethic and willingness to learn.
- Good communication and customer-service skills.
- Ability to complete paperwork accurately.
- Ability to work safely in varying weather and job-site conditions.

Preferred Qualifications

- Current tanker and hazardous-materials endorsements.
- Valid DOT medical certification.

Preferred Experience

- Previous lubricant, petroleum, agricultural, mechanical, or commercial delivery experience.
- Experience working with fuel tanks, pumps, hoses, meters, or dispensing equipment.
- General mechanical, plumbing, electrical, welding, fabrication, or equipment-repair experience.
- Knowledge of automotive, agricultural, industrial, or heavy-equipment lubricants.

- Forklift or other material-handling experience.

Physical Requirements

This is an active, hands-on position. The employee must be able to regularly enter and exit trucks; climb, bend, and reach; pull delivery hoses; use tools; lift and carry up to 50 pounds; and move heavier items with assistance or appropriate equipment.

Work is performed both indoors and outdoors and may involve varying weather, temperature, and job-site conditions.
