If you suffer from spring allergies, then you know they're no walk in the park. Although there are varying symptoms amongst individuals, they can all cause discomfort and inconvenience. Hopefully these tips can help you manage your allergies and health this spring season.

Allergies and Oral Health

On days where you need some extra assistance managing allergies – you might decide to take an over-the-counter antihistamine such as Zyrtec, Benadryl, or Allegra. While these often help lessen the severity of your allergy symptoms, a common side-effect is dry mouth. Dry mouth can also occur by breathing in and out of your mouth when your nose is stuffed up.

When your mouth is dry, you're not producing as much saliva as you normally would be. Saliva helps to wash away excess cavity causing bacteria in your mouth. To further protect your oral health in this vulnerable state, ensure you have your next cleaning scheduled. This way we can fully examine and clean your mouth to protect you from future decay and disease.



Allergy Management Tips

- Remove clothes worn outside that may be covered in pollen – and throw them in the washing machine.
- Likewise, take a shower the moment you get home to eliminate the pollen that may be on your body, and avoid spreading it to inside furniture.
- Wearing face masks can serve more reasons than one this season – they can help to filter pollen as well as protect others from bacteria from any sneezing and/or coughing.
- Check your local pollen forecasts to see if the pollen count will be extremely high that day – if so, take allergy medication before you leave the house.
- **Read allergy medication labels** to ensure you're not overdosing on the recommended usage. For example, if the label says, "take no more than 1 tablet every 24 hours", set an alarm to make sure you don't take another one before that 24 period is over (even if you feel you need it before that time).



Is a Dental Crown Right for You?

If you've googled or asked around about options to fix a damaged tooth, then I'm sure you've heard of a dental crown. But with so many dental options out there, it can be difficult to stay well-informed. You might find yourself with more questions than answers regarding: "What is a crown?" "What's the process to get one?" or "Why choose a crown over other tooth repair options?" Allow us to answer some of those questions for you.

What is a Crown

A crown is essentially a tooth-like cap that's put over your tooth for a number of reasons:


- To protect a weak tooth from damage such as fractures
- To restore an already fractured tooth
- To restore the appearance of a misshaped or discolored tooth
- To support a cosmetic modification
- As well as other health reasons at the Dentist's discretion



The Dental Crown Process

The crown process is fairly easy and straight forward.

1. First, Dr. Chubb will examine and prepare the tooth that needs a crown. This process involves x-rays and a mouth mold to ensure the lab matches the shape of your tooth.
2. Then we'll file down the outer layer of your tooth (a completely painless process) to create space for your crown.
3. We'll take an impression of your trimmed tooth and surrounding teeth so the crown fits just right.
4. We'll put a temporary crown over your tooth to protect it until your custom crown arrives from the lab.
5. When the crown arrives from the lab, you'll return for your second visit so we can cement your permanent crown to your tooth.



This entire procedure is safe, painless, and (with proper dental care) ensures a new and improved beautifully healthy tooth.

Why Choose a Dental Crown?

There are many options similar to dental crowns that can be used to repair the health and appearance of your mouth. So, what are the advantages of choosing a dental crown?

- Crowns are a simple procedure
- Can help relieve pain from damaged teeth
- Can restore the appearance of teeth
- Are custom made for you
