It's often said that eating too
much sugar will give you cavities but would you be surprised to
learn that sugar itself is not the
culprit?

Cavities form when the bacteria in your mouth uses the carbohydrates left over from your food to create plaque. Plaque erodes your enamel (your teeth's protective barrier) allowing the decaying process to begin - making plaque the real culprit. However, candy and other hard sugars can get stuck on and in between your teeth, making it harder for your saliva to wash away those plaque causing carbohydrates.
