Two Year Old:

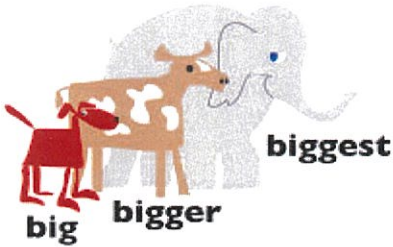


Unit: "Watch my Plant Grow", Spring
Number concepts: 1 - 7; one to one relationship
Shapes: Shape tree; Colors: Pastel colors
Phonics: Review "p" plant, "s" spring;
Spanish: 1-5; Language Arts: Gardening
Science: Planting a Seed
Music: "Here We Go Round the Mulberry Bush", Spring Theme
Perceptual Skills: Cutting shapes (Introduce scissors)



Three Year Old:

Unit: "From Seed to Flower", Spring
Phonics: Introduce "a" - apple
Number concepts: Recognition 1 - 9; rote counting 1 - 15
Colors: Mixing white to make pastel colors
Spanish: 1 - 9 (Please; thank you)
Perceptual skills: Sequence - small, medium, large plants
Science: How does a garden grow?
Language Arts: Spring has Sprung
Music: "Here We Go Round the Mulberry Bush", Spring Theme



Four Year Old:



Unit: How to Care for a Plant, Signs of Spring
Phonics: Review consonants
Alphabet: E - J, e - j (upper and lower)
Language Arts: Color words relating to gardening - spring colors
Number concepts: Introduce simple addition, 16 & 17; like set 1- 10; recognition 1 - 17
Shapes: review pentagon, introduce hexagon
Colors: Pastels
Spanish: Parts of face
Science: Sequential learning: Story of a plant - bird identification/ migration
Perceptual Skills: 12 seeds = 1 dozen
Music: Spring Theme
Role Playing: Let's Plant a Garden



Transitional:

Unit: See Sammy Seed Sprout; Spring
Phonics: Introduce "U", "UP" & "ET" family -review alphabet
Sight Words: Parts of a plant Perceptual Skills: story
Creative Dramatics: "I am a plant, watch me grow!"
Number concepts: Recognition 1 - 18; counting 1 - 40;
Review shapes: (games, tracing, drawing)
Colors: Green (Signs of Spring), Pastels
Science: Planting a Garden, Sequence of a Plant
Spanish: Parts of face;
Worksheets/Workbooks to reinforce numbers/phonics
Music: Spring Theme



Kindergarten:



Unit: Spring Fun - Everything is sprouting!
Continue Reading Books
Alphabet: "Bingo" emphasizing lower case letters continue manuscript printing - lower case; Phonics: Review short "O," "OT"
Perceptual Skills: Sequence; seed to flower
Number concepts: Recognition 1 - 100, emphasis on double numbers, workbooks, number progression, odd and even numbers, and ordinals
Science: Sam Seed sprouts this Spring! (plants & seeds)
Spanish: Days of week
Music: Spring Theme
Role Playing: Metamorphosis of a Butterfly
