2 Years Old:



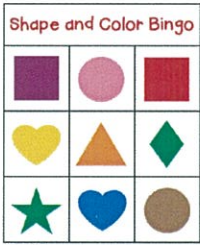
Units: Winter - Dinosaurs  
Number concepts: one to one relationship, count the dinosaurs  
Shapes: review circle, square, triangle  
Colors: Blue  
Phonics: "Dd" (dinosaurs), review "s" (snow)  
Perceptual skills: over, under  
Spanish: 3, Hola, Gracias  
Language arts: Show and Tell, Snow story  
Science: What is snow?  
Sensory play: Sense of smell  
Music: Group singing; Art: Chalk drawings



3 Years Old:



Units: Winter - Pets - Dinosaurs  
Number concepts: rote 6: Like sets 1-2  
Shapes: review circle, square, triangle, rectangle  
Colors: mixing colors: red, blue (purple)  
Phonics: "d" (dinosaurs), review Ss, Pp, Mm  
Perceptual skills: sorting pennies  
Spanish: Mi nombre es? (My name is ....), Hola, Gracias  
Language Arts: Pets are Our Friends - Stuffed animal pet show  
Science: freezing/thawing; (snow and/or ice)  
Role Playing: Pet Store clerk  
Music: Frosty the Snowman, group singing; Art: Winter scenes



4 Years Old:

Units: Winter in the Forest: Dinosaurs  
Number concepts: recognition 10-11; rote counting 1-11, like sets 1-7  
Shapes: introduce oval, review all shapes  
Colors: introduce white, mixing colors: blue, yellow (green)  
Phonics: Intro duce "at" family (mat, fat, sat): m, hPerceptual skills: writing name, tracing, cutting, phonics, sorting boxes  
Spanish: Introduce 7, Review all numbers, Hola, Buen Apetito  
Language Arts: recognition Aa - Ee; Sequencing Snowman story  
Science: weather changes, freezing/thawing  
Role Playing: Librarian; work sheets to reinforce number and phonics concepts  
Music: Rhythm Games; Art: Winter scenes



Transitional:



Units: Winter, Forest Animals, Hibernation, Dinosaurs  
Number concepts: visual recognition 1-10, like sets 1-10, rote counting 1-20  
Shapes: Introduce octagon, practice drawing shapes  
Colors: White (Review all color words), Mixing colors: blue, yellow (green)  
Phonics: Introduce Dd, Gg, Bb, Ii, "at" family  
Perceptual Skills: Alphabet Bingo, Color matching, Using a ruler  
Spanish: Introduce 10, Mi nombre es? (My name is ...), Review 1-9, Hola, Buen Apetito  
Language Arts: Sight words, 1(one) to 5(five), Nn-Ss  
Science: How animals adapt to winter  
Role playing: Librarian  
Music: Listening activities, Loud/Soft, Fast/Slow  
Art: Winter scenes

Kindergarten:



Units: Hibernation/Migration/Dinosaurs/Museums  
Phonics: review of "at", "ig", introduce "ot", "an", "op"  
Consonants: initial and final sounds/blending sounds into words.  
Spanish: Parts of the body  
Sight Words: Names of dinosaurs being studied; Introduce 11-20, Review 1-10  
Letters "K, V, N, Q, Y"  
Peceptual skills: (Modified) Outlines (listing traits of Dinosaurs; make Dinosaur book  
Number concepts: 11-20; greater than (>), less than (<); introduce counting by five's and ten's  
Science: The Earth at the Time of the Dinosaurs, Fossils (what fossils tell -paleontologists)  
Music: working with instruments  
Role play: Museum visitors, individual and group activity
