About the TRAVELLER study

The TRAVELLER study is designed to...



See if you might be a good fit for Roche clinical studies testing treatments to delay or prevent Alzheimer's disease.



Help find ways that may be used to detect Alzheimer's disease at an earlier stage.

Please note that participating in this study won't involve receiving any treatment, and it won't affect any treatments you are currently taking

Can I participate in this study?

You may be able to participate in the TRAVELLER study if you are:



50-90* years of age and willing to participate in a clinical study.

*Additional age restrictions may apply.

Why the TRAVELLER study is important for Alzheimer's disease research

The TRAVELLER study seeks to identify people who are best suited to participate in one of Roche's Alzheimer's disease clinical studies. This study also aims to engage with diverse communities to ensure we are inclusive, regardless of age, race, ethnicity, sex, physical ability, religion, and education or income level.

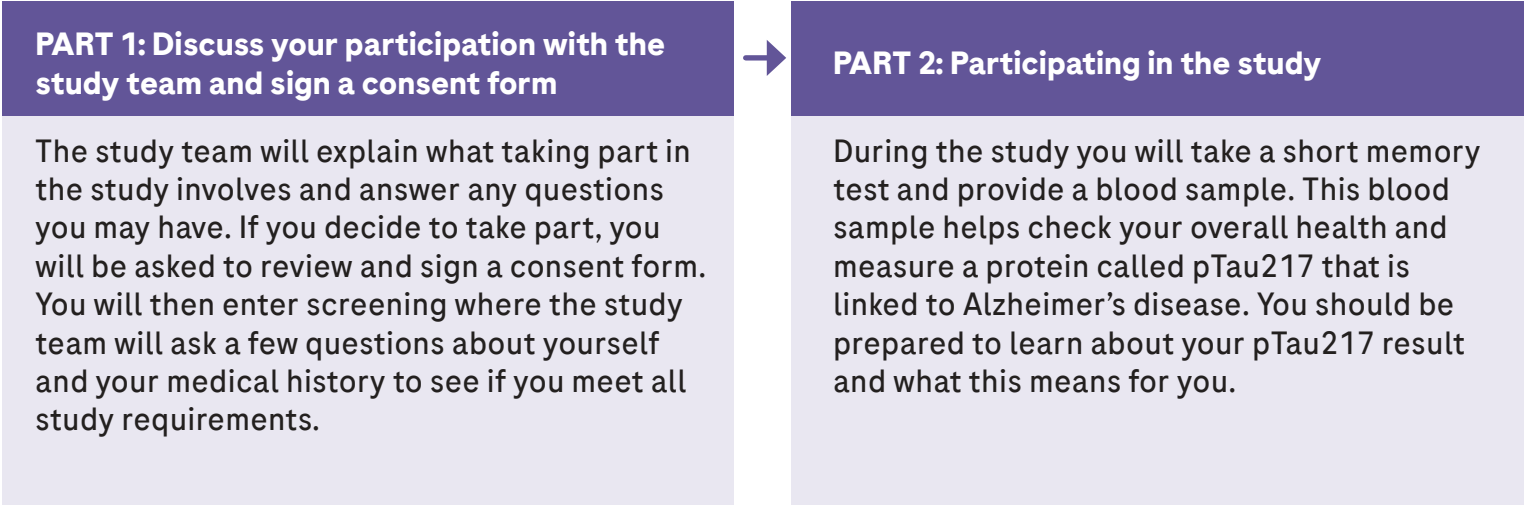
If after participating in the TRAVELLER study you are invited to a Roche Alzheimer's disease study, it does not mean you have Alzheimer's disease or that you will be eligible for other Roche studies. Your doctor will review the results from the study and provide you with options.

What does it mean to take part in the TRAVELLER study?

There are two main parts:



After you finish the two main parts, you will speak with your study doctor 1 or 2 times either in-clinic or over the phone, to discuss your general health and what your study results mean for you. They will also answer any questions you may have.

What happens after the TRAVELLER study?

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If your results show that you **may be suitable** for an ongoing or an upcoming Alzheimer’s disease study at Roche, the study team will contact you after completing TRAVELLER to discuss your potential participation.
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If your results show that you are **not likely to be suitable** for any of the ongoing or upcoming Roche studies at this point, your results may be reviewed for studies in the future. You may decide to join TRAVELLER a second time (after at least 12 months have passed).
