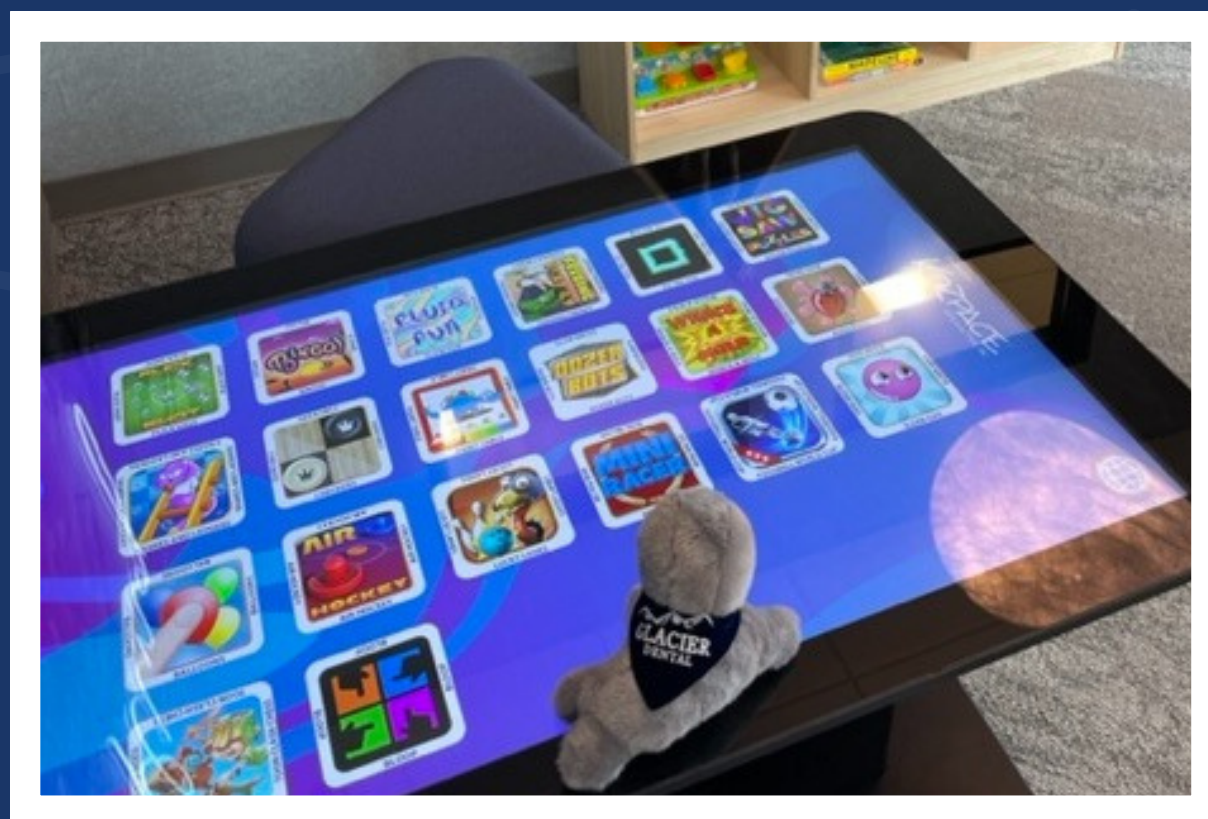
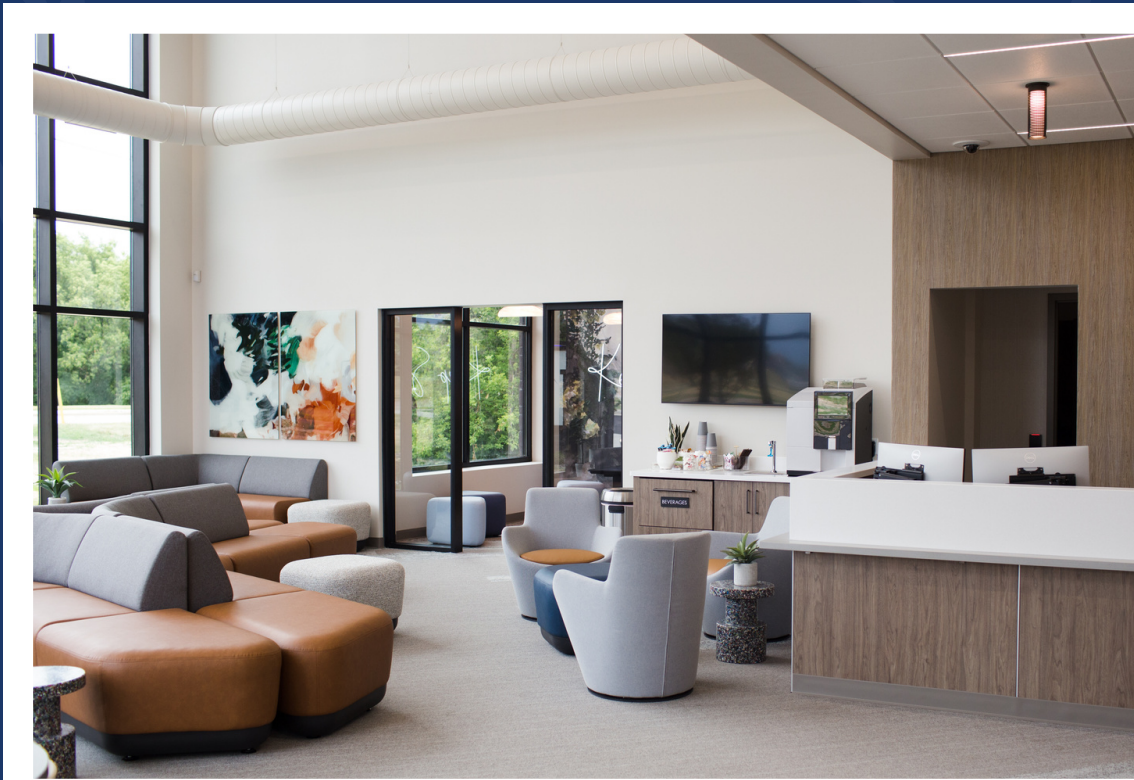
I am going to the dentist today to fix my teeth! First we will drive to the office and park in the parking lot.

Next one of the assistant will come to the waiting room and say my name. They are so excited to meet me!

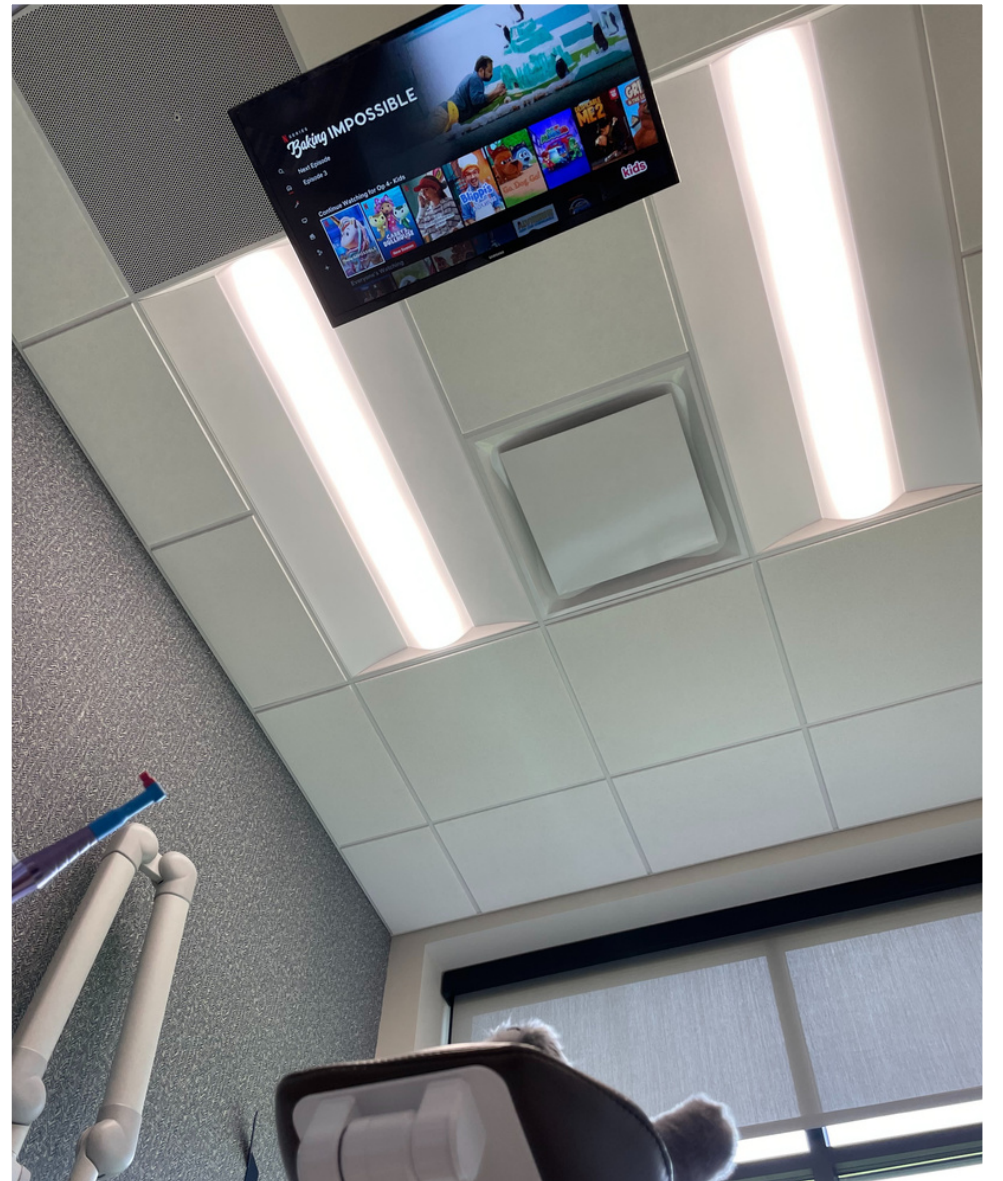


When I hear my name I stand up and say hi. They lead me down the hallway and bring me back to my room.

I wear a mask over my nose that smells like bubble gum! It smells yummy and helps me relax.



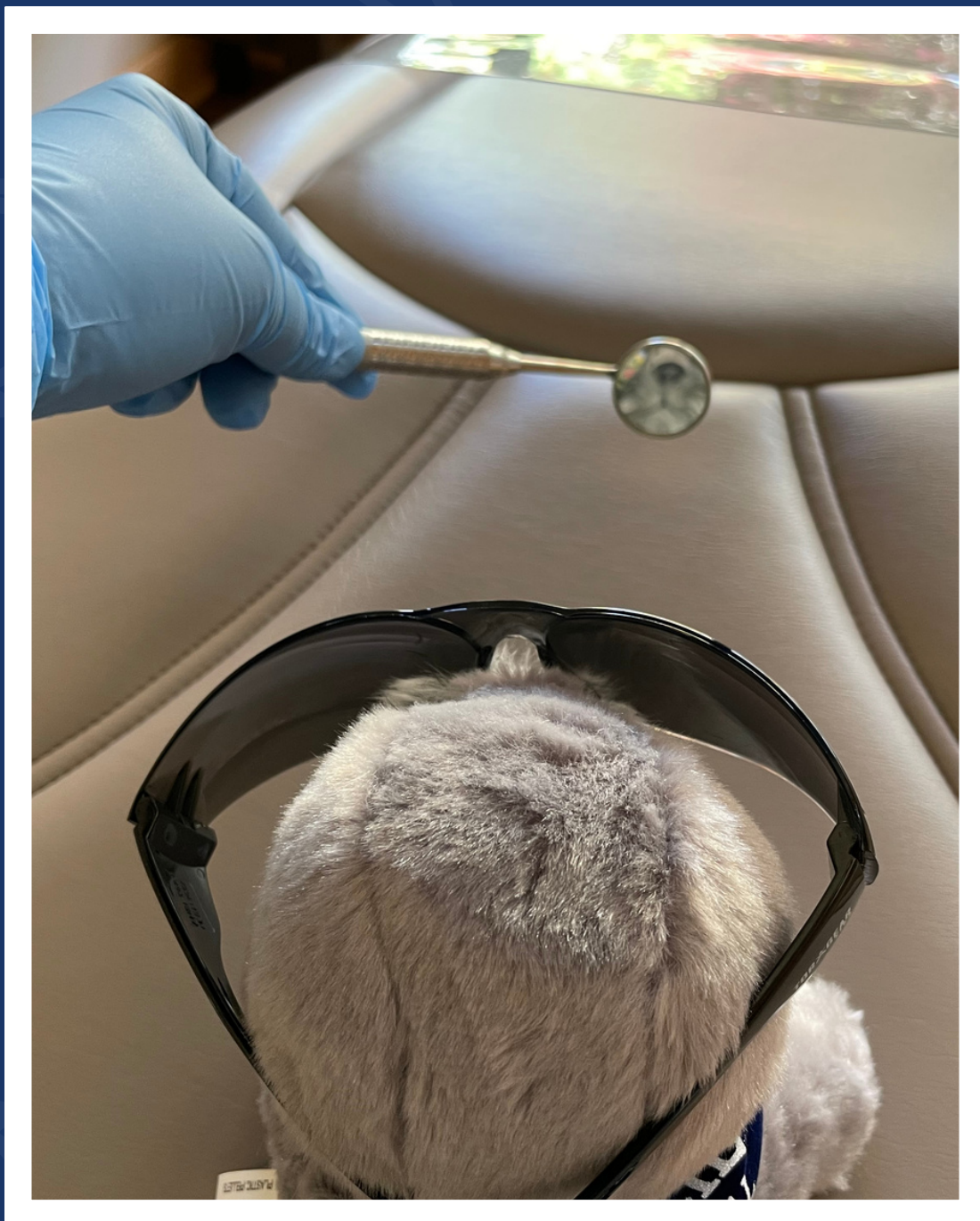
One of the dentists will come in to see me. They are very nice. I open big like a dinosaur, so they can see all of my teeth!



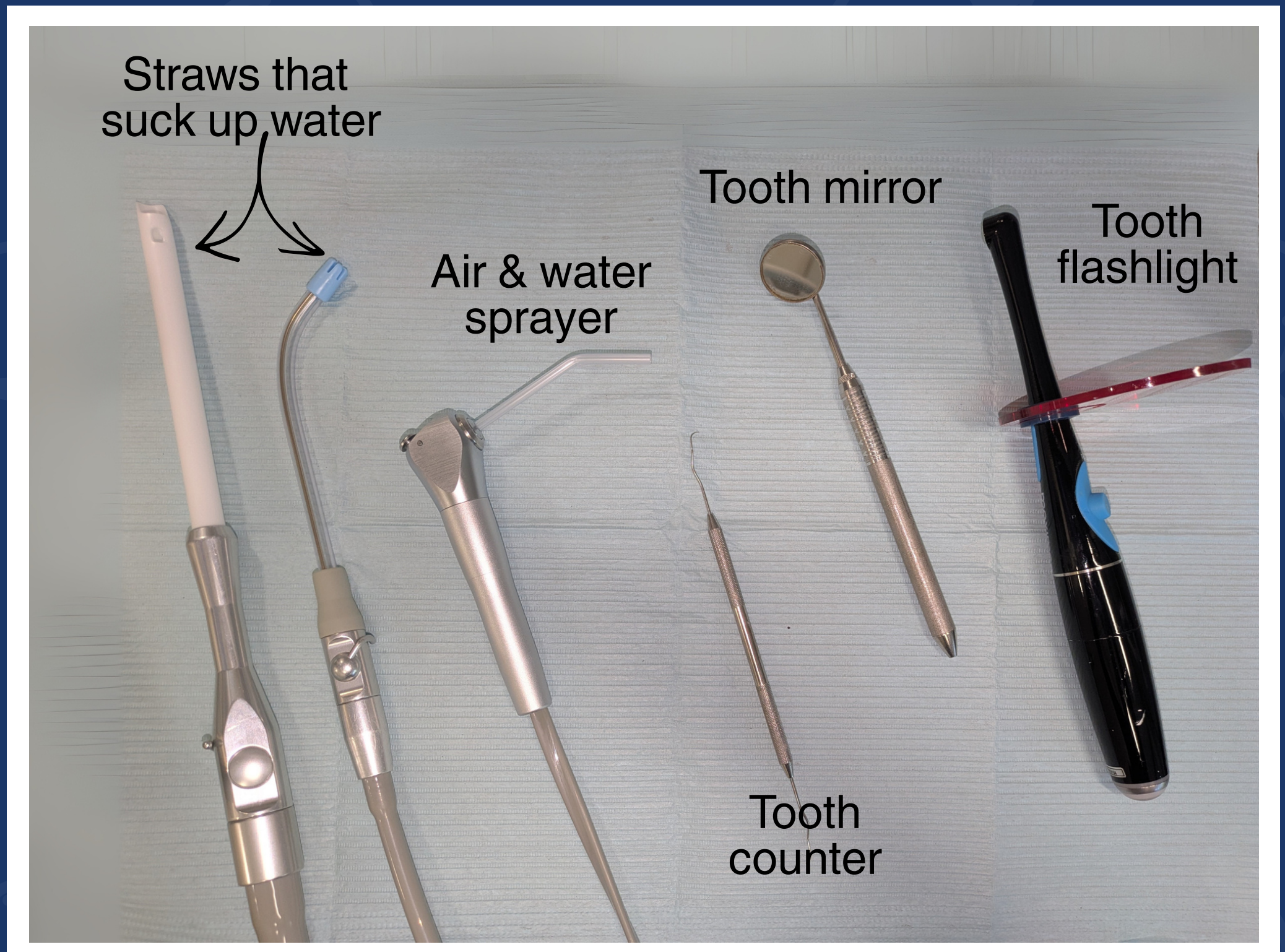

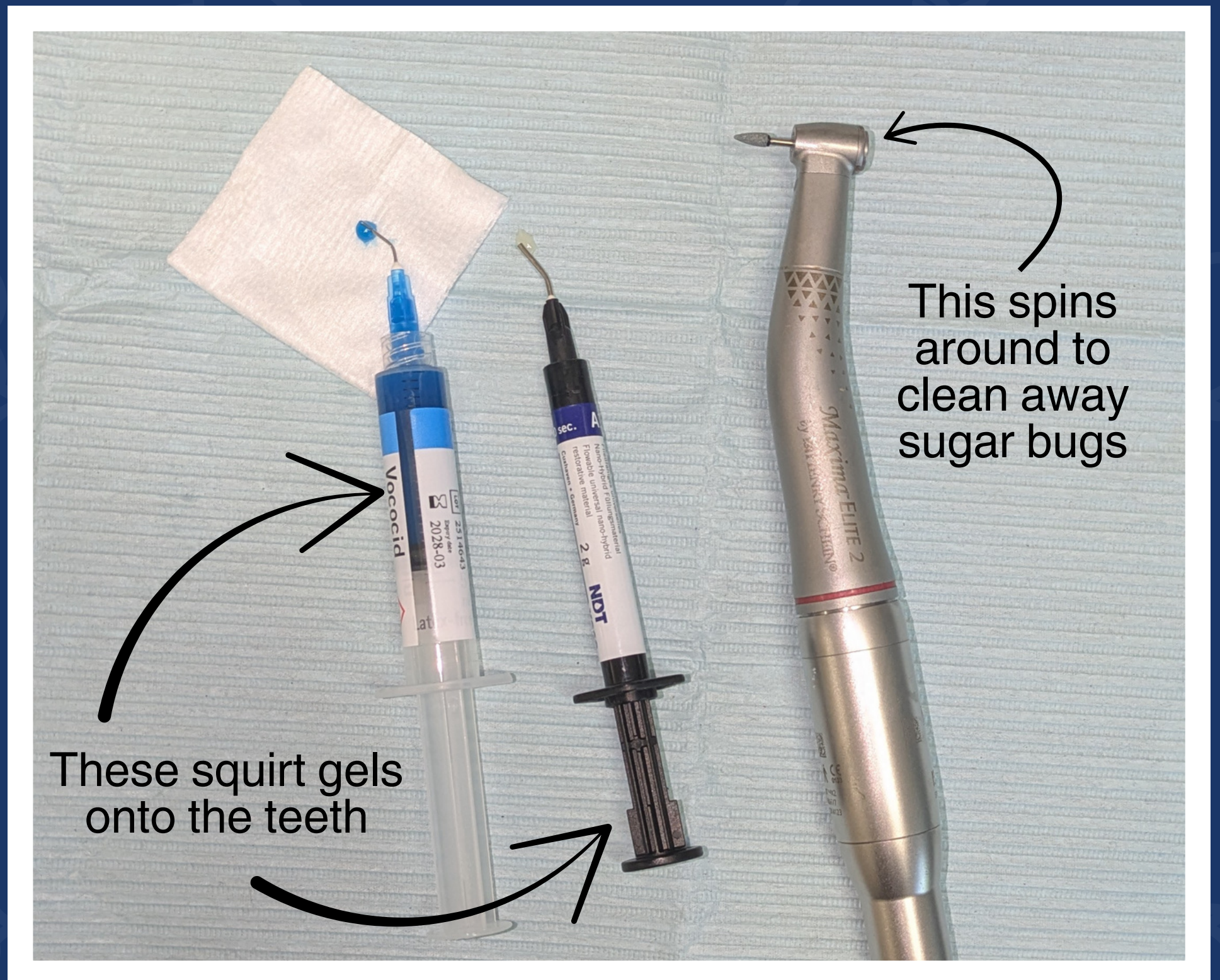
They use a squirt gun to rinse out my mouth and the water is sucked up with the straw, so I don't have to spit in the sink.
