Job Corps is Open and **Enrolling Now!**

It has been a busy fall for Job Corps admissions counselors. Background checks for students have resumed and our team is busy enrolling students. LifeSkills oversees three outreach and admissions contracts: two for the USDA Forest Service and one at the Cascades Job Corps Center. Our admissions team recruits eligible youth in Wisconsin, Missouri, Nebraska, Kentucky, Virginia, West Virginia, and Washington.

Recognizing Performance

For PY 2024 the Philadelphia OA contract was ranked number 1 on OA report cards. The Chicago contract was ranked 6th and Cascades was ranked 33rd.

The Chicago contract was ranked 5th for CTS performance, Philadelphia followed behind ranked 25th and the Cascades center ranked 65th.

The Cascades center finished PY 23 ranked 101 and increased to 57th for program year 2024. Amazing Work!


