What is work-based learning?

It's where students combine their education, career training, and soft skills with hands-on experience at real companies like yours.

Partner with Connect to host students for a structured learning activity that takes place in a workplace for a limited amount of time. The purpose is to provide the job seeker with the opportunities for career exploration and skill development, and is a mentoring opportunity for the employer.

The Connect program pays students wages and workman's comp insurance while they learn from you and your team.

IT INCREASES THE FOCUS ON DISADVANTAGED YOUTH FALLING IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES: HOMELESS, RUNAWAY, FOSTER CHILD, DISABLED, ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNER, OFFENDER, PREGNANT OR PARENTING, BASIC SKILLS DEFICIENT, OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL REQUIRING ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE TO COMPLETE AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM OR TO SECURE AND HOLD EMPLOYMENT.

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
