Bone Fracture Complications

In some cases, a person's bone fracture may require more than a simple procedure of resetting the bone and placing a cast around the area. These more substantial treatments can be caused by:

- Shattered bones, in which fragments may need to be retrieved
- Puncture injuries to nearby tissue after a shattered bone injury
- Fractures that also damage nearby nerves
- Fractures that develop bone infections

These complications and problems may call for surgical intervention, physical therapy, and drug prescriptions to see significant health improvement. Additionally, these treatments can prove very expensive for many injured individuals, putting them at risk of being burdened by medical debts after an injury that may not have been their fault.
