

2023 Standard Kennel Assembly Instruction Manual



#1Parts

Panels


- **1-Bottom**
- 2-Sides
- 1-Back
- 1-Door
- 1-Top
- **1-Alignment tool**
- 1-Bag of size 8-32 x 5/16" screws (A)
- 1-Bag of size $8-32 \times 1/2$ " screws (B)
- 1-Bag of size 8-32 x 3/8" screws (C) (Large & Xlarge only)

Side Panels

With the correct side (indicated by the engraving on the panel) facing the inside of the kennel and arrow pointing up (see figure #1) Insert one of the side panels into the channel on the Long side of the bottom panel. Make sure that the panel is in line with the channels on each end of the bottom.



#3 Side Panels

Repeat Page #2 for other side.



#4

Back & Door

With the correct side facing the inside of the kennel and arrow pointing up (indicated by the engraving on the panel) insert the back panel. Starting at the bottom align each side channel with the side panels. Tilting the panel, insert the back into the bottom channel. Repeat this step for attaching the front panel. The door panel can be installed either right or left handed. You may need to reverse the logo.

#5 Top

Starting at the back of the kennel, align the Top Panel. Use the pull tabs to help align the channels with each panel. Once the top is fully seated you can remove these tabs by pulling down and angled to one side.



Fastening The Channels


Check that all screw holes on each channel are lined up. Use the size 8-32 x 5/16" (A) stainless steel screws to fasten each of the panels. Do not over tighen the screws. It is recomended that you use only a hand screw driver to avoid over tighting. See next step for instructions on fastening the corner brackets.



#7 Alignment Tool


Use this Alignment Tool to help line up the holes on the corner brackets.

Note: Be careful not to push the threaded insert nut out of its recess into the kennel.



#8 Corner Brackets

If needed, use the supplied alignment tool to align the holes of each corner bracket and secure with screws. Use size $8-32 \times 5/16$ " (A) screws on all corner brackets with the exception of the 4 inner most holes of the corner brackets on the door panel. Use size $8-32 \times 1/2$ " (B) screws on these 4 inner most holes of the corners.



Warranty

KBC Kennels offers a 1-year limited warranty on manufacturer defects. KBC Kennels' only responsibility shall be limited to repair or replacement of the defective product. KBC Kennels will not be responsible for any costs, losses or damages incurred as a result of loss, shipping damage or use of product. This warranty is subject to the following limitations in addition to any imposed by virtue of applicable law.

Excluded from coverage under this warranty are the following but not limited to:

Damages from wear and tear

Impact-related damage

Damage resulting from abuse, misuse or carelessness

Intentional damage and/or breakage

Warpage from exposure to heavy weight on top, heat, rain, or snow

Damage resulting from improper installation

Any damage caused from anything other than defects in material or workmanship

Any Alterations or modifications done by customer

Damage from the use of solvents, adhesive, or cleaning solutions

Improper Installation

Failure to comply with Care and Use instructions

Please see the policy under returns and exchanges for return shipping info. The same policies apply to warranty shipping. To submit a warranty claim please email kbckennels@gmail.com, attach photos of damage, , address the subject heading to Warranty.

Please allow 14- business days for KBC Kennels to respond to potential warranty emails.

Customer is responsible for all freight/shipping charges. However, you will be credited for shipping if the product was defective upon receipt, or the wrong item was shipped. Please include the shipping receipt in your return package.

CARE AND USE:

Kennels should not be used in direct sunlight. Exposure to direct sunlight may result in unsafe temperatures for your pet.

KBC Kennels will not be held responsible for any injury to animals, persons, or personal property. Always use, store and install on flat/level surfaces. Placement of kennels on uneven surfaces may result in door alignment issues.

All latches should be properly and securely latched at all times. All tabs must be locked on a KBC Breakdown.

It is not recommended to leave pets unattended for long periods of time.

In some cases (i.e. high anxiety/ behavioral issues), this kennel is not a substitute for training or medications.

Grease kennel latch periodically for smooth operation.

Recommended cleaning for kennels: mild pet safe soap and water, rinse well and air dry.

KBC products should not be drug or thrown around.

All products wear over time.

Metal products that are powder coated or painted can chip over time.
