Did you know?

The demand for qualified nursing assistants is expected to continue to grow over the next few years. In fact, within 10 years, the number of job positions is expected to increase by about 18%.

Once licensed, you can transfer your Nurse Aide and Medication Aide License from state to state.

The median annual wage for nurse aides was \$38,200, with an hourly wage of \$18.33

There are over 43,247 Medication Aides currently employed in the United States. 84.3% of all medication aides are women, while 15.7% are men.

The projected job growth rate for medication aides is 9% from 2018 to 2028, with about 137,800 new jobs expected over the next decade.

The average annual salary for medication aides is \$40,799, with an hourly wage of approximately \$19.61.
