


John and Bec


Hello!




About John

Some of my hobbies include: baking cakes, painting, and bird watching. I love trying new things and taking classes to meet and learn from others.












About Us

We were both raised in the country and someday hope to make our forever home somewhere away from the hustle and bustle of the city.









John's Family







Bec's Family

We have many nieces and nephews who are important to us. We are also happy to be godparents to a handful of kids, both related to us and children of our friends.

















