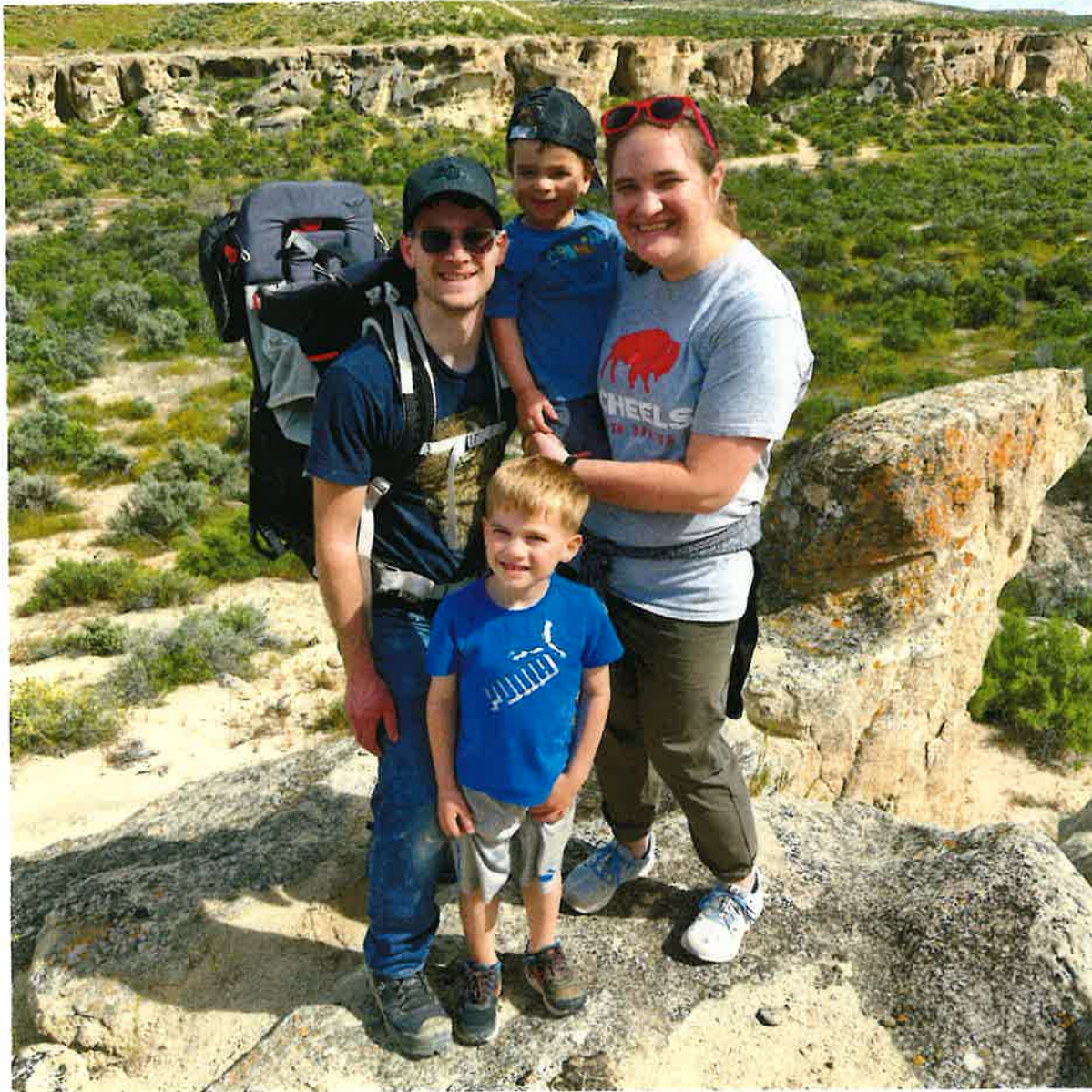

surrounded by family and friends*

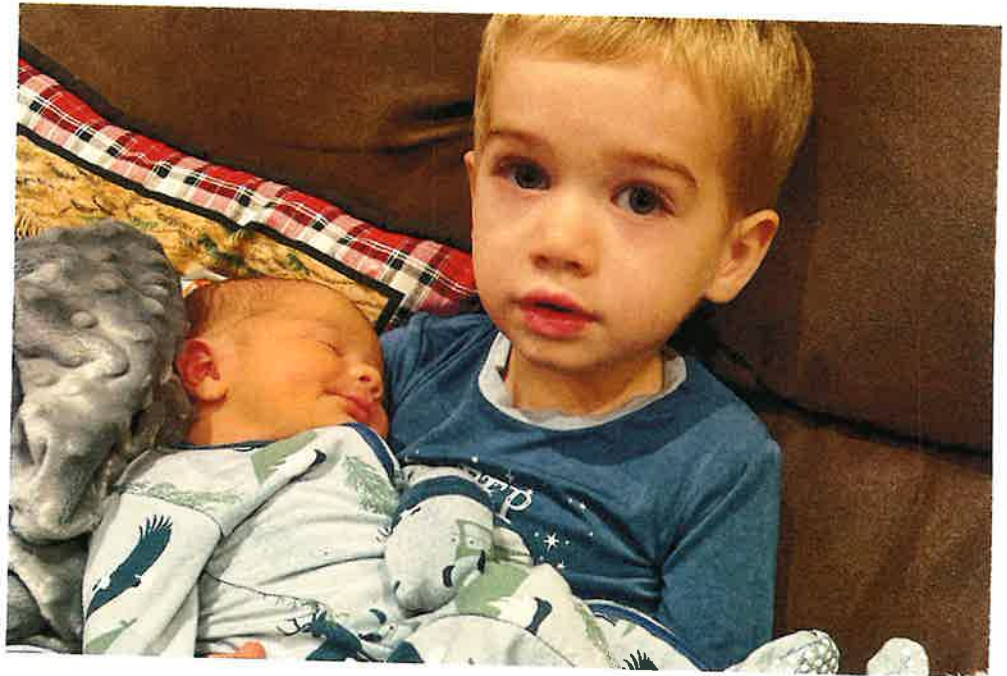

Family is important to us. Jason's parents and two older sisters live nearby and we cherish our time together. Jason has 13 nieces and nephews on his side of the family.





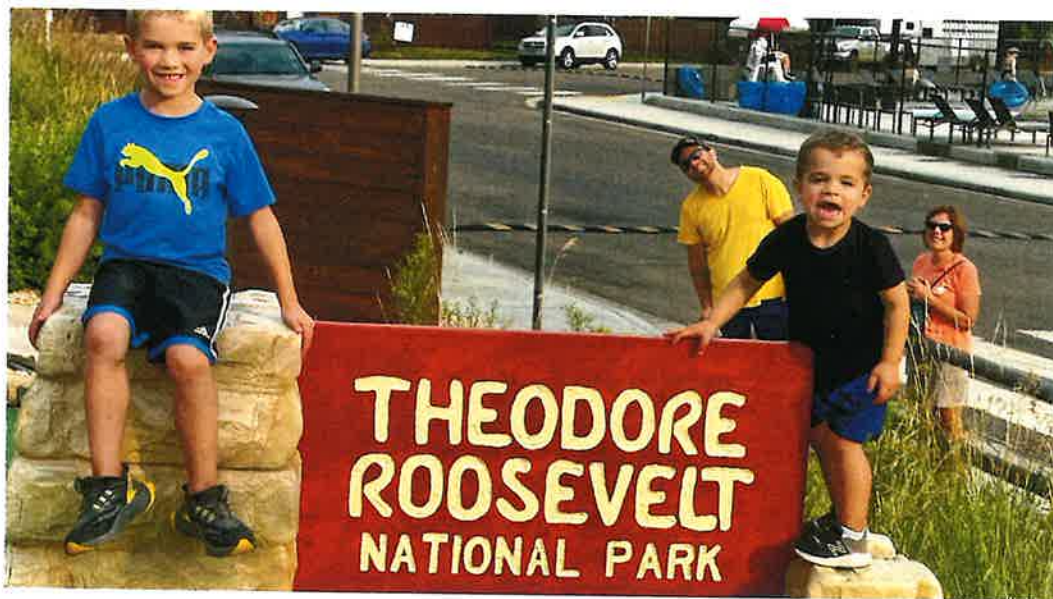

Britni's mom and dad are from Minnesota. Britni has two older brothers. One lives in North Dakota and one lives in Minnesota. We enjoy adventuring together.





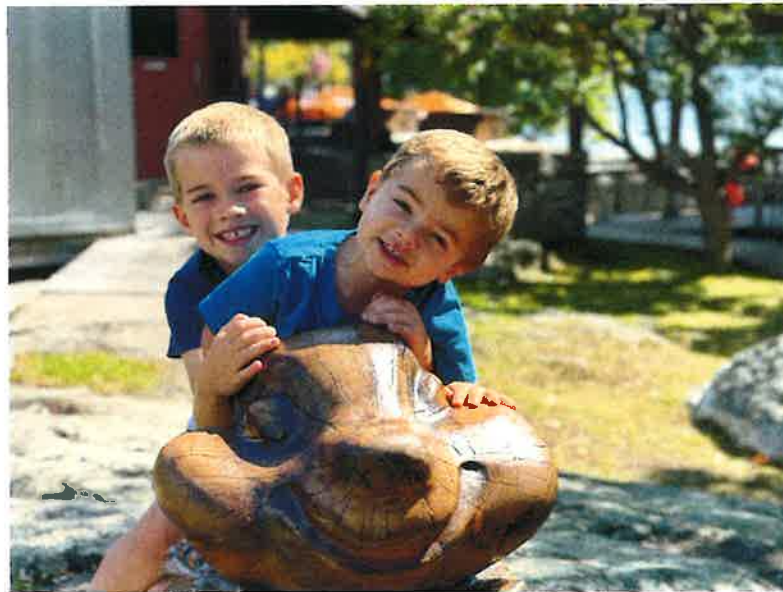

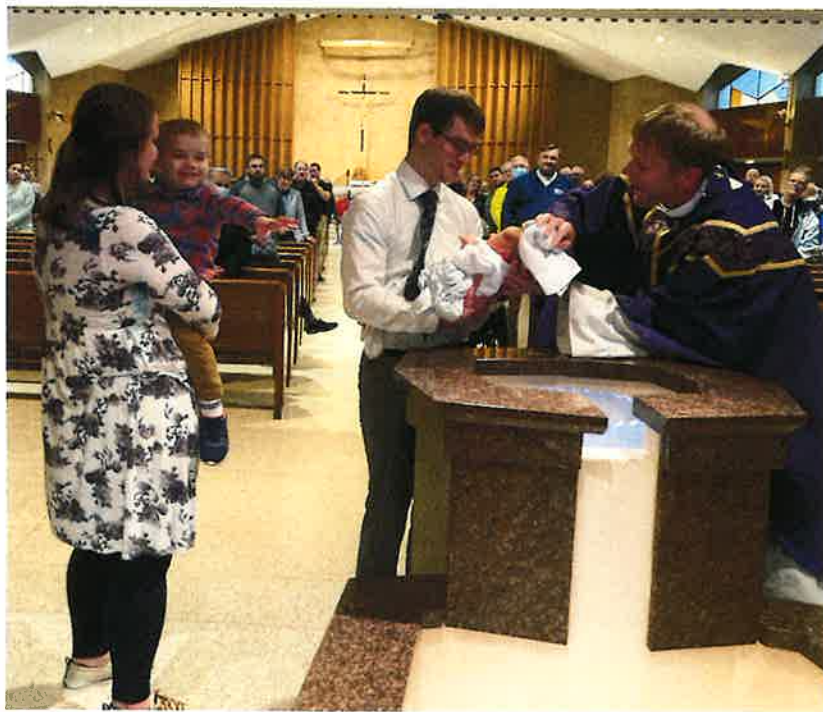


Our Faith
