### Newborn Insurance Policy

**You will have 30 days to add your child to an insurance policy anything insurance will not cover is your responsibility.**

Our practice firmly believes that a good doctor/patient relationship is based upon understanding and open communication. Your baby is typically covered by the parent's insurance within the first 30 days of life. However, it may take some processing time for your baby to be added to your insurance properly, so it is important to start the process as soon as possible.

We will be able to accept the parent's insurance card up until 1 month of age. Any visit after that will have to be considered a cash payment (due at the time of visit) for any child not added to an insurance policy. Once your child is 2 months of age and is still not added to an insurance policy, we will have no choice but to charge parents for the newborn office visit, and other office visits they have been seen for. This can potentially be anywhere from \$500.00 or more.
