## **Instructions for Paper Pattern/Template**

- 1. Use plain brown Kraft paper. We can provide this for you if needed. Do not use tissue paper, newspaper, or wrapping paper as these are not sturdy enough.
- 2. Cut the paper large enough to cover area being patterned (such as a radius corner) and make sure to extend the paper over the area at least 2" on ALL sides.
- 3. Cut small holes (about 2" wide) in the paper approximately 12"-18" apart and place painters tape over the holes to secure pattern/template to surface. It is crucial that the pattern/template is secure so that it does not move when traced. If you would prefer not to use tape, you can use a heavy object to hold pattern/template in place.
- 4. Hold a pen or a fine tipped marker at an angle while gently holding the paper near the edge and run the pen/marker along the edge. Do NOT use pencil and make sure there is a sharp, crisp line for us to follow.
- 5. Print your name on the template.
- 6. Do NOT fold or cut the pattern/template. Roll it up and secure with loose tape or a rubber band.

## Please keep in mind when ordering non-rectangular glass that requires a pattern/template:

- Pattern/Templates should be full sized and uncut
- Do NOT trace with pencil Please use a fine black marker
- Prepare pattern/template with "outside looking in" orientation.

Glass cutting has a 1/16" tolerance so your finished project may be 1/16" bigger or smaller
