Be our guest - let kitchen staff know in advance and you are welcome to join your family member for a meal - \$5 payable to the office.

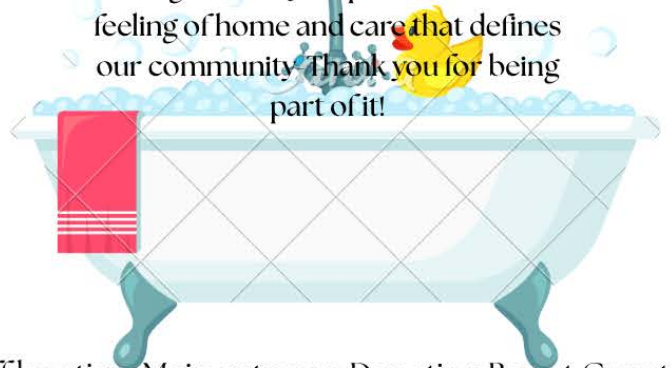
Country Villa Hygiene Drive
