As the hospital was so far away, I was born at home in my parents bed. We lived on a small farm in Sheboygan Falls and had 2 sisters. We went to the same one room school (even for my Dad) for all 8 grades, when the class outgrew the school, we were sent to the normal school for college classes. My Dad got emphysema and had to sell the farm. It was different: we all loved the farm. We were able to keep the gardens and dad took UW Madison courses in carpentry. In his new job he had gotten a stone in his eye and was sent to Madison for a new eye. I was working for the Mutual Insurance Co. when I meet my husband John. We married and had 5 children. I've always enjoyed sewing the kids clothes and later in life spent hundreds of hours quilting. Each of my adult children have at least 2 quilts and all my babys for 14 great grandchildren. We've done many projects for groups of people—and make wonderful quilts. I'm very happy I could share part of my life with you. Thank you for your welcoming smiles!
