GENERAL INFORMATION

Drone Lock is the latest polymer drift control technology specifically designed for drone applications, which helps to reduce drift and increase coverage. Drone Lock has a low use rate and displays excellent compatibility even in highly concentrated tank mixes. Use as a spray additive with herbicides, insecticides, and fungicides.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add this product to the spray tank last, after all other spray materials have been added and are thoroughly mixed. Use agitation when adding Drone Lock to tank mix. Always follow the pesticide manufacturer's recommendations for adjuvant type and rate. Conduct a jar test prior to full tank mixing to ensure compatibility.

RATE OF USE

1-2 oz/acre

FIRST AID

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a comfortable position for breathing.

IF ON SKIN (or clothing): Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin with water for at least 15 minutes.

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container only. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Do not store near heat or open flame.

Container Handling:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
