For your peace of mind, the measures we will be taking to provide a safe dental treatment experience include, but are not limited to, the following:

Upon Your Arrival at the Office

- Providing ample, well-ventilated space for our patients.
- Our large waiting room supports the social distancing protocols set forth by the public officials. The large waiting area also allows us to permit our patients to bring a support family member to their appointments.
- Enhancing our cleaning practices to include disinfecting waiting areas and front desk areas regularly.
- Eliminating the entrance of all non-essential vendors to the office.
- Hand sanitizers are available throughout our practice to help stop the spread of germs.
- If you are experiencing fever, cough, or shortness of breath, we request you call the office to postpone your appointment.

During Treatment

- Our infection control procedures have always exceeded federal guidelines. Our office protocols have always followed strict standard precautions. As a result, we have easily adapted to any and all new requirements and recommendations set forth by OSHA, the CDC and the ADA.
- As before, all rooms will be COMPLETELY sterilized before each patient is seated.
- Public areas, including restrooms, will be cleaned, and sterilized frequently throughout the day.
- Our team will STRICTLY follow guidelines set forth by the CDC, OSHA, and ADA regarding the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and office sterilization with fidelity.
