<u>Knapp v. Leonardo</u> (46 F.3d 170 [2nd Cir. 1995]) - Court of Appeals denied Writ of <u>Habeas</u> <u>Corpus</u> regarding murder trial held in Catholic Church Hall.

People v. Laurie Kellogg (210 AD2d 912) - retained by Seneca

County to represent the People of the State of New York in upholding murderer's judgment of conviction.

<u>Matter of Kelly F. v. Michael G.</u> (206 AD2d 227) - reversed Family Court abuse determination after validator's testimony was found to be insufficient.

<u>People v. Patrick M. Duffy</u> (79 NY2d 611) - first appellate ruling that defendant could be convicted of manslaughter in the second degree for reckless conduct that lead to suicide.

<u>People v. Kenneth Barton</u> (203 AD2d 911) - police search of vehicle held to be illegal and evidence suppressed.

Gandino v. Pelion, Inc. & Reagles (202 AD2d 963) - successfully overturned \$50,000 libel award and lawsuit dismissed.

<u>People v. Robert L. Norman</u> (202 AD2d 1013) - reversal of home builder's conviction for grand larceny and dismissal of Indictment; the Court of Appeals reversed and reinstated the conviction (85 NY2d 609).

<u>People v. Luevell Ballard</u> (201 AD2d 942) - appointed Special Onondaga County District Attorney to represent District Attorney's Office and upheld defendant's conviction for sale of drugs.

<u>People v. Titus L. Stewart</u> (199 AD2d 1043) - suppressed weapon found in vehicle because of an illegal search, Indictment dismissed.

<u>People v. Eric Fotiathis</u> (198 AD2d 896) - defendant's sentence as a second felony offender was invalid as a matter of law.

<u>People v. Frederick E. Fuller</u> (197 AD2d 881) - defendant granted new trial because he was not present during the entire trial.

<u>People v. Kathy Bernier</u> (197 AD2d 882) - defendant re-sentenced because trial court failed to properly determine restitution.

<u>People v. Robert L. Farmer</u> (188 AD2d 1063) - police illegally entered defendant's residence, evidence seized suppressed and Indictment dismissed.

<u>People v. Bernard "Buddy" Pynes</u> (170 AD2d 981) - defendant's conviction for drug sale reversed and Indictment dismissed; defendant had been sentenced to serve 15 years to life in prison.

United States v. Tarbell, Laughing and Burns (922 F.2d 1026 [2nd Cir. 1991])

- St. Regis Indians' appeal of Federal gambling convictions.

<u>People v. Peter Lancaster</u> (69 NY2d 20) - first appellate indication under new insanity law that District Attorney does not have to present to Grand Jury evidence of defendant's psychiatric history.

<u>Matter of Herald Company v. Mariani</u> (67 NY2d 668) - transcript of rape victim's preliminary hearing testimony, involving juvenile offender whose case was transferred to Family Court, is not available from City Court or Supreme Court.

<u>People v. Christopher Edwards</u> (64 NY2d 658 and 78 AD2d 582) first definitive statement of New York State criminal jurisdiction on an Indian Reservation.

<u>People v. Roger C. Smith</u> (62 NY2d 306) - first appellate recognition that a child abuse or neglect proceeding in Family Court does not invoke a defendant's right to counsel for criminal charges arising out of the same conduct.

<u>People v. Kirk Hughes</u> (59 NY2d 523) - first appellate consideration of the admissibility of hypnotically refreshed testimony in a criminal trial.

<u>People v. Norman Lipton</u> (54 NY2d 340) - sustained conviction of medical doctor for drug selling conspiracy involving false prescriptions.

<u>Matter of Priest and Raus v. Hennessy</u> (51 NY2d 62) - the attorneyclient privilege does not shield the identity of an individual who paid legal fees for certain women charged with prostitution.

<u>People v. Alfred Rolle</u> (44 NY2d 743) - upheld constitutionality of ABC Law §96(1) concerning illegal storage of alcoholic beverages after intermediate appellate court found it unconstitutional.

<u>People v. Thomas M. Hunter</u> (34 NY2d 432) - first definitive statement on prosecution of welfare frauds.

<u>People v. Charles and Marlene Henson</u> (33 NY2d 63) - first recognition of the Battered Child Syndrome in New York State.

<u>People v. Michael Bucci</u> (122 AD2d 562) - sentence imposed by trial court was illegal as a matter of law.

<u>People v. Cynthia Pugh</u> (107 AD2d 521) - murder conviction upheld over claims that District Attorney withheld evidence, and juror misconduct.

<u>People v. Simon Kuss</u> (81 AD2d 427) - first judicial sanction of utilization of verbatim transcripts of wiretap conversations by a jury during their deliberations.

<u>People v. Donald Greenwood</u> (81 AD2d 1038) - commended by Appellate Court for acknowledging that defendant's confession should be suppressed because he was improperly questioned without counsel being present, even though defendant failed to raise the issue.

<u>People v. Philip S. Whaley</u> (78 AD2d 588) - commended by Appellate Court for acknowledging that defendant's confession should be suppressed because he was improperly questioned without counsel being present.

<u>People v. Eric Loysen</u> (72 AD2d 970) - commended by Appellate Court for acknowledging that defendant was denied a fair trial and should be granted a new trial.

<u>People v. Melvin Gendron</u> (71 AD2d 1050) - commended by Appellate Court for acknowledging that defendant should have been permitted to withdraw his guilty plea when sentenced in excess of his plea bargain.

<u>People v. Morris Goldfeld</u> (60 AD2d 1) - upheld corroboration of accomplice testimony and sustained \$288,000 fine against defendant, in addition to jail term.

<u>Matter of Hennessy v. Cunningham</u> (57 AD2d 298) - denied authority to a successor judge to change the sentence imposed by prior judge after the appellate process was concluded.

<u>Matter of Holcombe v. Gusty</u> (51 AD2d 868) - placed District Attorney's Investigators in Exempt Civil Service Classification.

<u>People v. Michael Fortunato</u> (50 AD2d 38) - upheld search of probationer without prior court approval.

<u>People v. Ernest W. Speach</u> (49 AD2d 210) - first reported criminal prosecution of a public official for conflict of interest.

<u>Matter of Mora</u> (107 Misc2d 290) - first judicial recognition in the State of

New York that brain death is the equivalent of legal death.

<u>People v. Rosemary Jarvis</u> - 1972 - first felony welfare fraud conviction after trial in recent times in Onondaga County; affirmed on appeal, 52 AD2d 1067.
