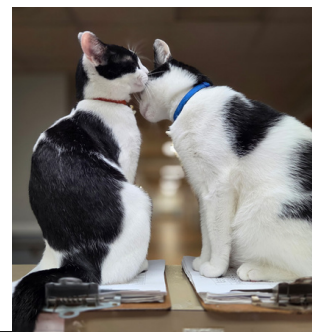
Some weeks are more difficult than others. Recently, we experienced an especially emotional week as we said goodbye to three of our beloved residents in a short period of time.

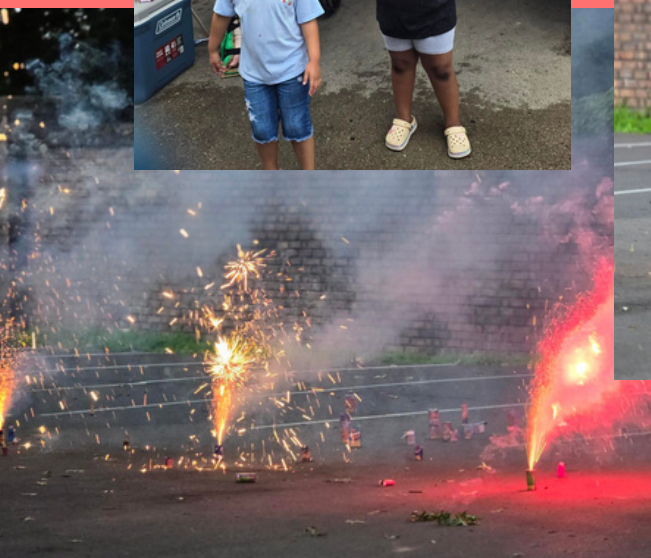
