Please take as few items as possible. Removed items will need to be treated with an alternate process

- People, Plants & Animals
- Take your wallet and keys but leave purses, backpacks, diaper bags, toys, briefcases, ect...
- Treat clothes that you will be wearing on treatment day in a high heat dryer for 30 min, then seal in a plastic bag.
- Stay off of infested furniture on treatment day.
- If taking a pet with you, leave bedding behind.

REMOVE THESE ITEMS

Wine/liquor

Medicines/vitamins

Wax items (candles, crayons, lipstick, etc)

Oil paintings & art supplies

Fire extinguishers/Pressurized cans

Batteries (bulk quantity or large batteries)

Antique furniture with finish or fragile glue points

Vinyl items

Plastic blinds

Live Plants

Perfumes/ Colognes

Firearms, bullets, explosives

Aerosol cans (hairspray, bug spray)

Musical instruments and collectibles

PLEASE DO THE FOLLOWING

- Remove all trash & garbage
- Launder soiled clothes
- Disengage fire sprinkler system

Dispose of vacuum cleaner bag
Do not use vacuum again until after
Consolidate electronics

PLEASE DO THE FOLLOWING (CONTINUED)

- Schedule disarming of home security system & smoke detectors
- Separate clothing to allow air circulation, this includes drawers & linen closets, as well as hanging clothes in the closets.
- Inform us of damaged or heavy furniture
- Unplug refrigerator
- Move all furniture and belongings a minimum of 2 feet from walls
- Please leave everything except for the items listed above in the home. This includes clothing, bedding, furniture. TV's and computers should be removed, however, can be covered with heat blankets if left behind. It's important to leave everything in place as bed bugs and their eggs may be found on nearly any item, and we want to ensure none survive or are brought back into the home.
- It is necessary to have access to electrical power
- Please provide access to the driveway for the heat treatment unit
- After heat treatment: the treated area will still be warm. Items will have been moved around to evenly distribute heat. You may cool the area down as needed and move everything back into place.
