DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR SEPTIC SYSTEMS

As you know, we will be providing you with a TURNKEY installation of your new SEPTIC SYSTEM. This means we will handle everything from start to finish. Including drawings, designs, permits, installation, and inspections.

In order for us to accomplish this, each county requires that we provide them with the attached forms filled out and signed by the actual owner of the property where the installation will occur. We are including sample(s) of the forms that apply to your specific installation requirements, to assist you in filling out the forms to your best ability. If there is ANYTHING on there that you can't fill in; don't worry. We will be happy to help with the completion. AND. Don't worry about the notary; as we have a notary here, and we will take care of that for you as well.

In addition to the attached forms, we ask that you provide us with a COPY OF YOUR WARRANTY DEED.

Each county requires that we submit ORIGINALS of the forms you will be filling out; so, we will need to work with you on the best way to get them from you. In person or by mail if you are not local.

Here are the steps we need for the installation process:

- 1) You will fill out the attached forms to the best of your abilities. IF you have ANY questions; please call us at 903-765-2903 so we can help you fill them out.
- 2) You must also provide a copy of the WARRANTY DEED for the property where the system will be installed.
- 3) You will let us know when you are finished so we can make arrangements to get the originals from you
- 4) We will go over the documents, and add or correct any information if necessary.
- 5) We will get the official drawing from a State Licensed Designer
- 6) We will take your original documents, along with the designers' drawings, and obtain the installation permit.
- 7) We will install your new Septic System
- 8) We will contact the county for a final inspection which is usually done the final day of installation.
- 9) Your payment is due in full on the final day of installation. Please see the form you will be signing entitled PAYMENT AND WIRING INSTRUCTIONS.

Submission of Application

Submit complete Application, Supporting Documents, and correct fee to the Van Zandt County's Fire Marshal's office. The accepted submitted permit and proof of payment will be given to the Designated Representative for review. All applications will be approved or denied within 30 days of receipt. Either an ATC or a letter of denial will be emailed to the Installer listed on the application.

Authorize to Construct (ATC)

Once the application is accepted the Designated Representative (DR) will review ALL documentation and either issue an ATC letter, request for clarification, require more information, or issue a rejection letter with cause.

DO NOT BEGIN CONSTRUCTION PRIOR TO OBTAINING AUTHORIZATION TO CONSTRUCT (ATC). THE RECEIPT FOR PAYMENT IS NOT AN ATC. UNAUTHORIZED CONSTRUCTION CAN RESULT IN CIVIL AND/OR ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES.

Final Inspection for Authorization to Operate (AO)

A Final Inspection of the installation is required before covering and operation of the system.

- o A request must be made via email, five (5) days prior to installation
- o Email must include:
 - Permit Number
 - Site Address
 - Requested date and time
 - The DR must have access to the property during the Final inspection
 - The Installer or an apprentice must be on-site during the inspection
 - If the system passes the Final inspection an Approval to Operate (AO) will be emailed within seven (7) business days.
 - **If a system fails:**
 - A Report will be issued with the issues needing to be corrected
 - A Reinspection fee must be paid before rescheduling the final
 - System will not be used until an AO is issued. Failure to comply may result in civil, administrative, and/or criminal fines

After a successful inspection, an Authorized to Operate (AO) will be issued to the owner and/or Installing company.

OSSF Maintenance and Management Practices of water conservation measures

PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS

HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE -- CHAPTER 366

Sec. 366.004 Compliance Required

A person may not construct, alter, repair or extend, or cause to be constructed, altered, repaired or extended an on-site sewage disposal system that does not comply with this chapter and applicable rules.

Sec. 366.051 Permit

(a) A person must hold a permit and an approved plan to construct, alter, repair, extend or operate an on-site sewage disposal system.

Sec. 366.054 Notice from Installer

An installer may not begin construction, alteration, repair or extension of an on-site sewage disposal system unless the installer notifies the commission or authorized agent of the date on which the installer plans to begin work on the system.

Sec. 366.055 Inspection

(b) An on-site sewage disposal system may not be used unless it is inspected and approved by the commission or authorized agent.

Sec. 366.056 Approval of On-Site Sewage Disposal System

(c) If a system is not approved under this section, the on-site sewage disposal system may not be used until all deficiencies are corrected and the system is

Re-inspected and approved by the commission or authorized agent.

Sec. 366.057 Permit Issuance

(b) A permit and approved plan to construct, alter, repair, extend, or operate an on-site sewage disposal system must be issued in the name of the person who owns the system and must identify the specific property location or address for the specific construction, alteration, extension, repair, or operation proposed by the person.

This document *is* not a representation or warranty by the TCEQ or the local permitting authority of the suitability of this OSSF, nor does it constitute any guarantee by the TCEQ or the local permitting authority that the appropriate OSSF was installed.

INSTALLATION OF SEPTIC SYSTEM RELEASE OF LIABILITY DETAILS

By signing this document below, the customer who has commissioned us to install their septic system of any type, understand that Curtis J. Harris Enterprises, LLC dba All Pro Septic, shall be held harmless and released from any and all liabilities pertaining to the following.

1- SITE INFORMATION:

- a. Customer understands that areas identified and agreed upon by both All Pro Septic and the owner as installation area requirements, may be subject to the disruption of present locations of dirt, plants, trees, grass, etc.

2- LIABILITY FOR UNDERGROUND AREAS:

- a. Customer understands that All Pro Septic shall NOT be responsible for damage to any underground utilities, piping, sprinkler lines, etc that are not clearly marked or identified prior to installation day.

- 3- ELECTRICAL POWER:** It is the liability and responsibility of the HOMEOWNER to ensure that there is electrical power available if it is required for this project. All Pro Septic are NOT LICENSED ELECTRICIANS, and will and can only perform the electrical plug-in to the homeowners power source. IF, an electrician is required, it shall be the responsibility of the HOMEOWNER to utilize a licensed electrician, at their own expense.
