(PREMIUM LOW CHLORINE ALTERNATIVE)

New Season Start Up

1. After the pool is filled and the filter system is operating properly. Check and adjust the water chemistry (PH, Alkalinity, Calcium and Phosphates) to ensure the new chemicals work correctly, maintain quality swimmer comfort level and to safeguard equipment longevity and warranties remain valid.

(Free water testing at Viscount of Canton)

(PH: 7.2 - 7.8, Alkalinity: 80 - 120, Calcium Hardness: 200 - 300, Phosphates: 0 - 500)

2. Test and adjust the waters Cyanuric Acid (Stabilizer or Conditioner) to stabilize Chlorine.

(Cyanuric Acid: 30 - 75) * Slow dissolving chemical, put in a nylon or sock and hang in front of the pools return jet. This may take a few weeks to dissolve in cold water.

3. Add _____ lbs. **Pool Shock** (1lb. per 10'000 gallons of fresh water) Circulate 24 hours
(If water is cloudy or discolored Double Shock with 2lbs. per 10'000 gallons)

4. Add _____ oz. **Viscount Poly 30**, (12oz. per 10'000 gallons) Circulate 24 hours

(Install a new **VISION Nature 2/9 Limited CRT Mineral Cartridge** to start each new season)

Weekly Maintenance

Wednesday:

1. Check Water Chemistry and adjust if necessary .
2. Add _____ Add **Viscount Quick Tabs** (2 Tabs per 10'000 Gallons) or _____ cups **Viscount Premium Soft Cal Chlor Ultra AC Granular** (1 cup per 10'000 Gallons)

*** Viscount Quick Tabs should ONLY be placed in the skimmer basket with filter on high speed until dissolved. Never put Quick Tabs in a Floater or Chlorinator ***

Sunday:

1. Add _____ **Viscount Quick Tabs** or _____ cups **Viscount Premium Soft Cal Chlor Ultra AC granular**.
2. Add _____ cups **Viscount Shock & Swim Non-Chlorine Shock** (2 cups per 10'000 Gallons)
3. Add _____ oz. **Viscount Poly 30 Algaecide** (4oz per 10'000 Gallons)
4. Add _____ oz. **Viscount Nature Clear Enzyme Treatment** (4oz per 10'000 Gallons)
5. Add _____ cups **Viscount Anchor It** (2 cups per 10'000 Gallons)

*** Viscount of Canton recommends to **Filter / Circulate** your pool water on **High Speed 12 hours daily** (night time filtration is more effective and cost efficient) or **24 hours on Low Speed** ***
