REMINDER FROM PUBLIC WORKS:

LEAF PICKUP:

- Rake leaves to curb. Keep in large piles rather than multiple small piles.
- Leaf pick-up is usually 3rd Wednesday of December, followed by street sweeping. Street parking should be avoided if possible. If you don't have off street parking available, please be courteous to your neighbor and park in front of your own home. Collection date will be posted.
- Please <u>don't mix grass, twigs</u>, or <u>vines with the leaves</u>. This could result in leaves not being picked up.

You always have option to bag leaves for weekly trash pickup, this will avoid blowing leaves, water build up, and possibility of plowing leaf piles should it snow.

BRANCH AND SHRUB: There will be no collection by Borough of cut large branches. Shrub trimmings should be bagged and put out with regular trash collection. Twigs and small branches should be cut to 4-foot pieces and placed in trash can or bundled (up to 40lbs) for regular trash pickup. Large <u>fallen</u> branches only shall be placed at curb and picked up by Borough periodically.

ICE AND SNOW REMINDER: Please remember to put your car in the driveway when there is significant snow in the forecast so that public works can do a thorough job of plowing. Also, drivers are now required by state law to remove all snow and ice from their cars before driving. Fines of at least \$25.00 and up to \$75.00 may be assessed.

HOLIDAY FIRE SAFETY TIPS:

- Replace all Christmas lights that have frayed or damaged wiring.
- Keep live trees well-watered.
- Have a working smoke detector installed near the area of your tree.
- Never leave candles unattended!
- Practice a family escape plan. When a fire hits, seconds count!

NEED HELP PAYING FOR HEAT? Programs are available for New Jersey residents who need assistance with utility payments:

LIHEAP (Low Income Energy Assistance Program) – helps very low-income residents with heating and cooling bills. **UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND (USF)** – Credits to make energy bills more affordable for low- income customers. **WINTER TERMINATION PROGRAM** – prevents utilities from being cut off from qualified customers between November 15 and March 15.
