

Dress Code for Headshot Photoshoots, Auditions, and Agent Day

Keep in mind that anytime you come to the Agency, please look presentable, as if you are going to an audition. Talent, who DO NOT look appropriate, are not taken seriously in this industry.

❖ Dress Code tips:

➤ Wear a **solid jewel tone color** (no neon colors):



- Blues (Best color)
- Pinks
- Yellows
- Oranges
- Greens
- Salmon
- Purples



- Headshots and most auditions are “On Camera” Collared tops and V-necks are the most flattering on camera.

DO NOT WEAR:

Stripes, Logos, Plaids, Busy looking shirt. No Red, Black, Brown, or White.

- If you have long hair, make sure it is pulled or pinned back. This will make sure your hair doesn't fall in your eyes or face during your photoshoot and/or audition. Your hair could shadow your face or hide your facial features. Clients want to see your face.



- *No Jeans that have holes or rips*
- *No flip flops*
- *No short skirts*
- *No big jewelry*
- *No Tennis Shoe*
- *No see through clothing*
- *No chipped fingernail polish*
