

Little Lobes

Information On Little Lobes

- Please read the following information before booking your child's appointment. If special accommodations are needed please reach out before scheduling.
- Little lobes piercings are for children 12 years of age and under. Appointments are required and available from open until 5 pm, depending on piercers available.
- Children ages 5 and under will be required to have a consultation with the piercer at least 24 hours of scheduled appointment.

All Children Must Be Actively Supervised

- Inksmith has a NO unattended child policy. All children must have an adult present that is not receiving a tattoo or piercing. This is for the safety of everyone involved. If you have two or more children coming in for a piercing you must have two or more adults present to actively supervise.
- Families are allowed to have one child and two adults in the piercing room. No additional friends, family, or children will be allowed in the piercing room. This is for the safety of everyone involved.
- We do allow photographs in the piercing room, however we do not allow any videotaping.

Upon Arrival

- You will be asked to file a hold harmless agreement on a digital device. Please bring a state issued or federal issued ID. Children 12 years of age and under will need a birth certificate and matching last names with the parent present. You could also bring a passport for the child or adult.
(Ages 13- 17, must bring a form of identification. This can include a state issued ID, a passport, or a school ID)

Aftercare

Now that you've had your ear lobes pierced, please make sure you are not touching them without freshly washed hands. Keep in mind that we should never sleep on fresh piercings. Utilize a travel pillow if you are a side sleeper.

Clean your piercings 2-3 times daily for the first week, and twice daily for the remainder of the healing process. Utilize Q-tips or non-woven gauze to keep the piercing site clean and dry.

If your child bathes or showers nightly, please dry their hair before bedtime to reduce the moisture and pressure combination, which is our leading issue in healing lobe piercings.

Lobe piercings take approximately 10 weeks to heal, keep the initial jewelry in for the full 10 weeks. After 10 weeks feel free to change the jewelry into anything you'd like, keeping something in for the first full year as to make the piercing viable.

Please do not submerge your fresh piercing for 14 days. That includes pools, hot tubs, lakes, bathtubs, and oceans. After 10 weeks you can change your jewelry into anything you like. Keep in mind you are more than welcome to come back for jewelry changes forever.
