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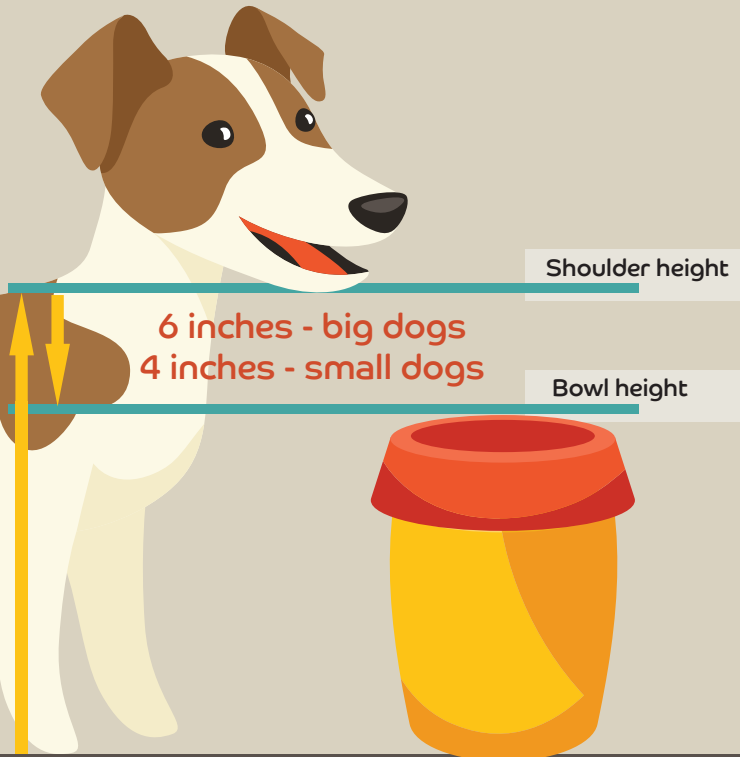
SENIOR DOG COMFORT CARE

How to properly elevate your dog's bowls

Elevated food and water bowls allow a senior dog to eat without having to lean down and forward, helping to relieve stress and discomfort.

To determine proper height

1. Measure the distance from the floor to your dog's shoulder while standing
2. Subtract 6 inches (4 inches for smaller dogs) from that measurement
3. Raise bowl to that height



TIP: Your senior dog should be able to eat without lowering their neck or stretching it upwards
