GENERAL PRICE LIST:

The prices are effective as of revision date **April 1, 2026**, and are subject to change without notice.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC), the New York State Department of Health and the New York City Department of Consumer Affairs require funeral providers to make certain disclosures on the general price list. These disclosures are similar but are not exactly the same.

FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION (FTC) DISCLOSURE: The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specially ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

NEW YORK AND NEW YORK CITY DISCLOSURES: The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our services. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral services and merchandise you selected.

This list may not include prices for certain items you select, such as cemetery charges or crematory services, flowers and newspapers notices. The estimated of final prices for those items will be shown on the itemized statement describing the funeral services and merchandise you selected , we charge you for our services in buying certain items.

Your authorization is required for a funeral home to obtain custody of a body and a body must be released promptly upon request and to embalm or not to embalm.

The provider of funeral services is required to give price information in Person and over the telephone.

A provider of funeral services is prohibited from representing that the deterioration of human remains can be prevented for more than a limited time by embalming, caskets, vaults or outer interment receptacles.

ALTERNATIVE SERVICES:

The following charges for direct burial and direct cremation do not include additional items or services, merchandise, facility use and livery that the customer may wish to select. **ALSO NOT COVERED ARE NYC DEPT OF HEALTH FEES.**

New York State, County and New York City Department of Health fees are extra necessary fees in order to process an approval also any outside fees to obtain the permit approval. The funeral home does not make money on this. This is added extra onto all bills, contracts and agreements that must be paid by the client.

DIRECT CREMATION:

Price range from \$ 1875 to \$4000

Which includes the transfer of remains to the funeral home, the funeral director and staff services, securing of necessary authorization, Local transportation to the crematory, an alternative container for cremation and the return of the remains to the funeral home. **To price of \$1675:** Which includes the services as described above but with the cremation container supplied by the customer. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you may use an unfinished wooden box or an alternative container. Alternative containers can be made of heavy cardboard, pressed wood or composition materials (with or without an outside covering) or maybe pouches of canvas or other materials.

DIRECT BURIALS: Price range from \$2900. Which includes the local transfer of remains to the funeral home. The funeral director and staff services securing of necessary authorizations, local transportation to the cemetery and an unfinished wooden box.

To price of \$2312. Which includes the services described above but with the container supplied by the customer.

The direct burial prices do not include cemetery charges.

In New York state embalming is not required by law. If you do not want embalming you have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for embalming such as direct cremation or direct burial. If you select certain funeral arrangement such as viewing or an open casket funeral.

Embalming:

Embalming may be required by the funeral firm. Other preparation (excluding embalming) preparation of the remains unless selected is not required for direct cremation or for direct burial.

A. Topical Disinfection:	\$400.
B. Custodial Care (<i>Charged after 24 hrs</i>):	\$100/per day
<i>Custodial Care will not be charged on the days when embalming or other preparation of remains occurs. Visitation is held or a funeral service is conducted.</i>

Transportation beyond local point of shipment will be billed either as livery or common carrier charges depending upon the forwarding location. Local point of shipment is up to or within 10 miles.

Receiving remains from another funeral home: This charge includes basic local transportation of the remains to the funeral home and or place of local disposition, staff services and securing necessary authorizations, the charge does not include additional items of services, merchandise, and facility.

Use and livery that the customer may wish to select Price is \$2500. Transportation beyond local place of disposition will be billed as livery charges. Local place of disposition is up to or within 10 miles.

Cash Advances: services and merchandise provided as cash advance items will be billed at the same amount paid by the funeral firm.
